



THE TURNINGPOINT – Approaches for sustainable architecture

We are at a turning point, characterised by ecological and related societal and social demands – especially on built architecture.

Sustainable building is urgent. Innovative approaches, sustainable architecture and urban spaces for climate and socially appropriate built environments with architectural quality are emerging. There are many approaches, but which ones make sense, which ones are promising? What are their advantages and disadvantages? What has not yet been considered? Are sophisticated technologies panaceas or do we even have to return to the comprehensive and fundamental qualities inherent in our historical building materials? Recycling of building materials seems to be gaining an increasing share in new construction lately. And anyway, to what extent is the re-use of buildings and/or their conversion preferable to new construction? More questions than answers seem to be on the table at the moment.

However – approaches to sustainable architecture can be found in many parts of the world and are in the process of further development. We have selected a few striking ones and brought their protagonists to Hamburg. For 12 years now, prominent architects from all over the world have been presenting outstanding examples of best practice – the state of the art – at the International Architecture Forum. This will also be the case in 2022.
